

Winter weather is challenging, especially in the canyons and UDOT wants to keep you safe. During severe winter weather, drivers must have:




STEEL LINK OR CABLE CHAINS

OR



TIRES WITH WITH M+S
OR 3PMSF RATING; WITH OR
WITHOUT STUDS

Per Utah Administrative Code R920-6



2WD vehicles must have 3PMSF rated tires on all wheels or chains on all drive wheels.

4WD/AWD vehicles must have M+S, 3PMSF rated tires or chains on all wheels.
